Bicyclic lactone **A** is submitted to the indicated reaction conditions.

- a) Give the structure of intermediate **B** and product **C**.
- b) Draw the relevant transition state [B ->C] in a suitable 3D-perspective, and use it as base for your arguments to show that product C is indeed formed selectively as a single diastereomer.

When we "cut" the indicated blue bond in lactone **A**, we get ester **D**. We subject it to the same reactions conditions as earlier.

- c) Draw the relevant intermediates and transition states in a suitable 3D-perspective,
 - and use them to argue which diastereomer **E** you would expect to be the dominantly formed reaction product.
- d) What would the outcome be if HMPA was omitted in the transformation of D?
