# Graded Assignment 1 - Instructions

Please read these instructions carefully.

### Just before the start of the assignment

You should be seated at the indicated seat in the room assigned to you and **ready to start** working by 8h15.

- Locate your room and find your seat (check moodle, check the listing in front of the room)
- Put your camipro card on your table
- Start your laptop or the provided computer
  - If you need the provided computer but it does not work, please report it as quickly as possible to the assistants.

#### Rules:

- The only electronic device allowed is your computer.
  - ← Put any electronic device other than your computer (phone, smart watch, earphones...) into your bag, and the bag on the side of the room.

Note: if you have your course documents on a tablet, you should transfer your documents to your computer before the assignment.

- On your laptop or computer, make sure to close:
  - Any communication software (whatsapp, slack...)
  - Any development environment (VS Code, etc.)
     Note: If you previously worked on VS Code, make sure to download your notebooks into noto before the start of the exam.

## Beginning of the assignment

The assignment starts at 8h15 and you have 1h30 in total, except special arrangements.

#### To start the assignment:

- Open a web browser (Firefox or Chrome for instance)
- Go to: <a href="https://noto.epfl.ch">https://noto.epfl.ch</a>
- Log in using your EPFL Gaspar account
- Once the assignment starts (at 8h15 on October 15, not before!), you will see a folder called "cs-290-graded-1" into your noto workspace
  - If you don't see this folder once the assignment has started, please contact the assistants as quickly as possible.
- Open the notebook "Graded\_1.ipynb" and start to work directly into the notebook, following the instructions in the notebook
  - ♠ Do not rename or move the notebook!
- Make sure to save your work regularly either by clicking on the floppy icon (\(\begin{align\*}{\begin{align\*}{ccc} \begin{align\*}{cccc} \begin{a

#### Rules:

• You MUST use noto, you cannot use another development environment (VS Code etc.)

- You can access all the course documents and the previous notebooks, your notes, and search the web.
- It is prohibited to use GenAl tools such as Copilot, ChatGPT, etc.
- It is prohibited to communicate with any other person, whether by electronic means or in the room.


### End of the assignment

You are **not allowed to leave the room before time is over**, which will be indicated by the assistants (normally at 9h45).

You MUST submit your work before leaving the room.

Follow this procedure to submit your work:


- Make sure to save your work in the notebook either by clicking on the floppy icon ( ) at
  the top of the notebook, clicking on the menu File > Save Notebook or by using the
  keyboard shortcut Ctrl+s
- Go to the moodle page of the course: <a href="https://moodle.epfl.ch/course/view.php?id=18548">https://moodle.epfl.ch/course/view.php?id=18548</a>
- Find the assignment called "Submit your Graded Assignment 1"
- Click on the button "Add submission"



- You should see the content of your noto workspace:

  - Click on the button "Save changes"

This will make a **copy** of the folder with all its content, zip it and send it to moodle.



• You should then see a screen with a green line at the top indicating "Submitted for grading", which indicates that the submission is successful.



Note: you should just ignore the sentence "No notebooks were provided for this assignment" as it only indicates that the teacher has not provided a notebook for the assignment in moodle.

If you want to check what you have submitted, you can use the link "View submission" at the bottom of the screen: this will make a <u>copy</u> of your submission back into your noto workspace. In noto, you can then open this copy and check that it contains what you want.

<u>↑ Once you have submitted your notebook to moodle</u>, any change that you make on your notebook on noto is ignored!

If you want the changes to be taken into account for grading, you MUST resubmit your work - provided that time is not over and that you are still in the exam room.
