## Run Biogeme on the virtual desktop service (VDI)

You can connect to the VDIs directly in a web browser (by going to <a href="https://vdi.epfl.ch">https://vdi.epfl.ch</a> ) or via the "VMware Horizon" client application which you can also download from <a href="https://vdi.epfl.ch">https://vdi.epfl.ch</a>.

Set "vdi.epfl.ch" as a server, then open the "ENAC-SGC" pool.

Anaconda and Biogeme are already installed. The software can be accessed from the "GC Programs" folder on the desktop.

Access from the internal network (wired network and EPFL WIFI, thin client classrooms, etc.) requires username and password. Access to this service from outside the campus requires the <a href="EPFL security">EPFL security</a> <a href="Code">Code</a> in addition to the username and password.
