Tips for your revisions

Planify your revisions

Make an agenda for every class you have to review. Preoritize by credits and by ease.

Prevent distractions

Move away your phone, social networs etc...
Concentrate on your work

Take some breaks

Every 1h to 3h, discociate from your work, take 5 to 15 min Do something you like, use the 'pomodoro technique'

Setup a nice tidy study space

If your environment is attractive, you will be more productive Discociate eating and working.

Practice a lot!

Do you exercise sets, do some exams.
Be efficient and focus on the concepts
Skip long processes you know you can do reliably

At the start, focus on the basis and general concepts

Learn the concepts, and how to use them first It is normal to struggle Train on a bit of everything

In the end, focus on efficiency and reliability

You understood most of the concepts, great!
Focus on saving time and not making errors when solving

Make your formula table

Train on your exercises

Train every major concepts

Write every thing you need

When you need something like a formula, a diagram, methods, constants to make your formula table.

Make your formula table

Use what you wrote before,
Make it beautiful, readable, easy to use
Organize by concepts
Think about organisation before hand, do a draft
Leave a bit of place
Put a little motivation, funny thing, drawing, easter egg

Train on exam WITH your table

Learn it by heart by training on exams Correct errors, add some missing ideas

Tips for the exam

Good luck

Start by the easiest

Do the easiest questions first then advance to the hardest

Be clean

You should put the corrector in the nicest position

Explain everything

You might need to guess, do something wrong, even if it is, explain it...

Take your time but be efficient

Try to be as efficient as possible, stay calm, Take a break if you are tired, stay relax, good luck.
