

## **BIO-455 : Introduction to Law and Ethics**

### **Exam procedure**

The oral examination will take place on **January 27 and 28, 2026**, according to the registrations on Moodle.

The examination will be held in room: **CM010**. Preparation will take place in **CM011**.

The time indicated in the exam schedule under “Start time” corresponds to the start of the exam in front of the teachers. The exam itself lasts **15 minutes**.

Students **MUST arrive 25 minutes at CM011** before the start time of the exam in order to draw their question and prepare for it.

Students are asked to pay close attention to their order of appearance in order to ensure that the session runs smoothly.

Students must also ensure that they have the following to hand:

- Their Camipro card (or other valid photo ID) to verify their identity.
- The list of exam questions, so that they can draw their question when the time comes.

The list of exam questions will be available on Moodle.

Students will be welcomed by the teaching assistant, who will verify their identity and have them draw their exam question. To confirm their identity, students must show the assistant their Camipro card with photo (or another valid photo ID).

Students will then have **15 minutes to prepare** before taking their exam at the scheduled time. Students must be able to answer the selected question (7–10 minutes). They will then be questioned on their answer or on related theoretical aspects (5 minutes).

Students will **NOT** have access to their lecture notes, course materials, or library resources. Some legal texts such as the constitution will be available to students. Students are only allowed to bring their pen. Paper will be provided.

The examination can be done in either English or French.
