Using and producing information

Day 1: recap

- Scientific information is a social phenomenon : it connects researchers through direct contact or documents ; documents can be linked with others as well ; for specific applications networks can also include molecules, universities, or anything that can be identified precisely
- Scientific information (in general or just in chemistry) is usually available through a number of resources, i.e. documents or search tools
- Different document types follow different publication workflows
- Search tools are designed to cover different document types or contexts ; different tools can take advantage of different connection types
- A search query on a given tool can be more or less efficient. Most search tools provide functionalities to adjust a basic query until it fits your needs, and repeat the same search periodically to check for new results
- • AI is increasingly present
