Grading of exam (computations)

- 60 % computation (problem solving step)
 - 2/3 computation (40 % of total grade)
 - 1/3 units (20 % of total grade)
- 30 % final result
 - 2/3 final result (20 % of total grade)
 - exact result $\pm 10\%$ $\rightarrow 20\%$
 - exact result $\pm 30\%$ $\rightarrow 10\%$
 - 1/3 units of final result (10 % of total grade)
- 10 % for sentence and correct interpretation of the result

Grading of exam (questions)

- Read the questions carefully and **respond precisely** to the question (any additional information that was not asked for will not give any additional points, do not waste time by writing everything you know, but focus on what is asked)
- each correct answer counts
 - e.g. three answers are asked for: each correct answer gives 33 %
- wrong answers can be counted negative (1/2)
 - e.g. two correct and one clearly wrong answers are given (two answers asked for) → $2 \times 50 \%$ (two answers were expected) - $1 \times 50/2 \% = 75 \%$ of maximum grade
- no negative final grades are given for an exercise
 - e.g. three answers are asked for; one correct answer and two wrong ones → 0 % of maximum grade
