

Poster session on December 9

- The poster session will include one-slide pitch from each team (3 min) and oral presentations of your posters (10 min) evaluated by your peers, and by Tiffany or the TAs.

- Each poster team is assigned to a session, either in the role of evaluator or presenter (10 min presentation).
- As a presenter, your job is to present your poster and answer questions. As an evaluator, your job is to evaluate posters (we will give you a grading sheet)
