

INSTRUCTIONS FOR BIO-372 "MICROBIOLOGY" 1st EXAM

Please arrive at the exam room (CE 1.106) no later than 14:10 in order to avoid delays.

You should **bring a calculator (this is important! please don't forget!)** but you may not bring notes, books, computers, or phones with you to your assigned desk. Backpacks must be left at the front of the room.

When you arrive, find your assigned desk and sit down. Your desk will be labeled with your name and a number. The envelope containing your exam will be on your desk. Please check to make sure that the name and number on your desk correspond to the name and number on your exam envelope - and that the name is correct! ☺

Do not open your exam envelope until I give the instruction to do so.

The format of the exam is multiple-choice and short-answer questions, like the exercises. Your answers do not need to be full-length sentences. If you wish, you may draw diagrams or pictures to help illustrate your answers. Sometimes a simple diagram can save you a lot of writing. If you need more space, continue on the back of the page.

The exam questions are in English. Your responses may be written in English or in French, whichever you prefer (you may even use both). Grammar, spelling, and punctuation are not important, as long as the meaning is clear. Please try to write as neatly as you can; if your writing is not readable, I can't give you credit.

The exam covers weeks 1-3 of BIO-372. There are 5 questions per week x 3 weeks = 15 questions in total. Grading follows the same procedure as the exercises. Each question is worth one point. If you answer 0 of the 5 questions for a week your score will be "1.0" for that week; if you answer 1 of the 5 questions your score will be "2.0" maximum (depending on the quality of your answer); if you answer 2 of the 5 questions your score will be "3.0" maximum; and so on. Your final grade for the exam will be calculated as the average score for all 3 weeks.

If you have any questions during the exam, please bring your exam to the desk at the front of the room to ask me (I will be there throughout the exam).

If you need to visit the WC during the exam, please come to the desk at the front of the room. A TA will accompany you to the WC (but only as far as the WC door!).

When you finish your exam, return it to the envelope (*please do not seal the envelope!*) and bring it to the desk at the front of the room. You must show me your Camipro card when you hand in your exam (this is required by the Service Académique).

Make sure you sign the "exam submitted" list when you hand in your exam, before you leave the room! This is required by the Service Académique!
