

Water Resources Engineering and Management (CIVIL-466)

Exam procedure

When: **June 27, 9:00 – 12:15**

Where: **GC A 3 30; GC C 3 30**

Type: **written, closed book, 1 page A4 (1 side) of formula/notes allowed (student choice)**

Exam value: the exam counts for 70% of the total grade, the other 30% being the project report. The final note will be so calculated

$$G_{\text{final}} = 1 + 5 * (0.3 * G_{\text{proj}} / 100 + 0.7 * G_{\text{exam}} / 100)$$

where both the exam and the report grades are expressed in percentages.

The exam procedure will follow the Lex 2.6.1 rules. Student places will be pre-assigned. Students will find their name on the desk and have to produce their camipro card for identification. Students are requested to arrive at least 30 minutes before the exam starts. Teachers will be present for the whole duration.

Students disposition

Letter A – L (numbers 1 – 35) → Classroom GC A 3 30

Letter M – Z (numbers 36 – 69) → Classroom GC C 3 30

The student will find her/his place numbered according to the list. Students are not allowed to change place nor to leave the room after 12:00 until the end of the exam. The exam questions will be already found at the desk “facing down” and **cannot be reversed and turned face up** until the exam begins.

The exam will consist of five (5) questions, three exercises and two theoretical questions to be answered in written form. Calculation procedures have to be shown in clear at least in the general procedure. Calculations only showing the result and with unclear origin or procedure will be disregarded and not graded. The exercise questions are reflecting the exercise sections done during the semester, with possible small deviations due to the examination confidential protocol, but always reflecting the general thematic already seen in classroom lecture sessions.

Only pocket scientific calculators are allowed, the use of cellphones (any kind), I-pod, etc. are strictly forbidden. On the desk only a pen, the exam material and the 1 A4 page (1 side) with your selected formulas will be allowed.

At the end of the exam, students will remain seated until all material is collected and counted.
