Introduction (8 pts)	<p>The introduction includes a) information on the broad topic (e.g., organic matter in streams), b) the specific treatment being tested (e.g., leaf litter type), and c) clearly states a testable hypothesis. Citations of the scientific literature are included to help support claims.</p>	<p>Introduction is missing one of the parts described in the 100% credit section, and/or is missing literature citations.</p>	<p>Introduction is not relevant to the subject matter, does not include a hypothesis, and is missing any literature citations.</p>
Methods (8 pts)	<p>The methods describe the experimental setup, including a) the materials used and constructed to complete the investigation, b) the treatment and any manipulations done during the investigation, and c) data collection and analysis, including relevant statistics.</p>	<p>The methods are missing one of the parts included in the 100% credit section.</p>	<p>The methods are not relevant to the subject matter, or fail to describe any of the three parts included in the 100% credit section.</p>
Formatting and structure (4 pts)	<p>The text is written in paragraph form, sections are clearly labelled, and citations are consistently formatted.</p>	<p>Issues in formatting or grammar prevent easy interpretation of the text, and citations are inconsistently formatted.</p>	<p>The text is poorly written and difficult to understand. Sections are not labelled. Citations are inconsistent or not included.</p>
