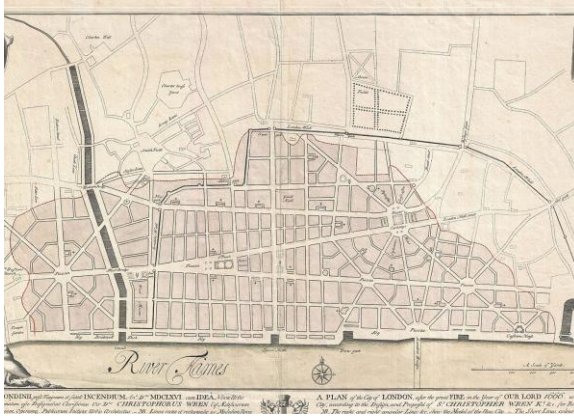
**Hausman Paris Plan 1853**



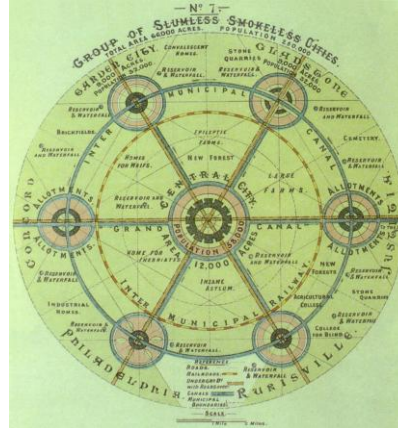
**Radiant City 1930**



**1666 Christopher Wren's London Plan**

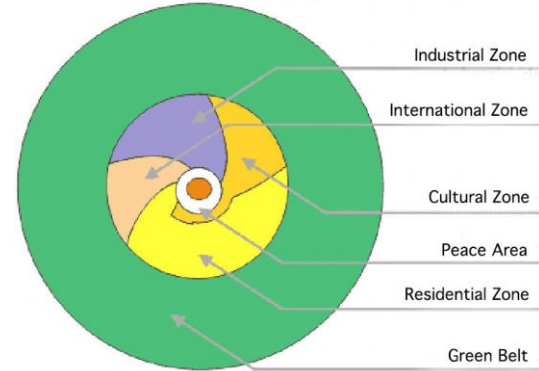


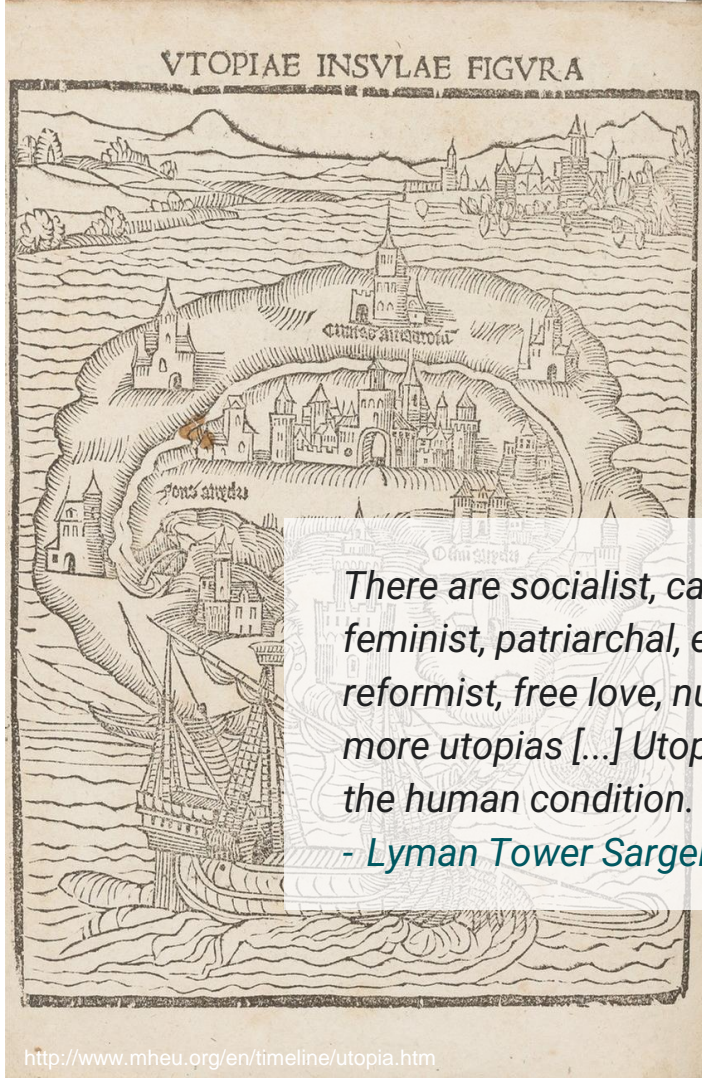

Peace Area, City Zones, and Green Belt

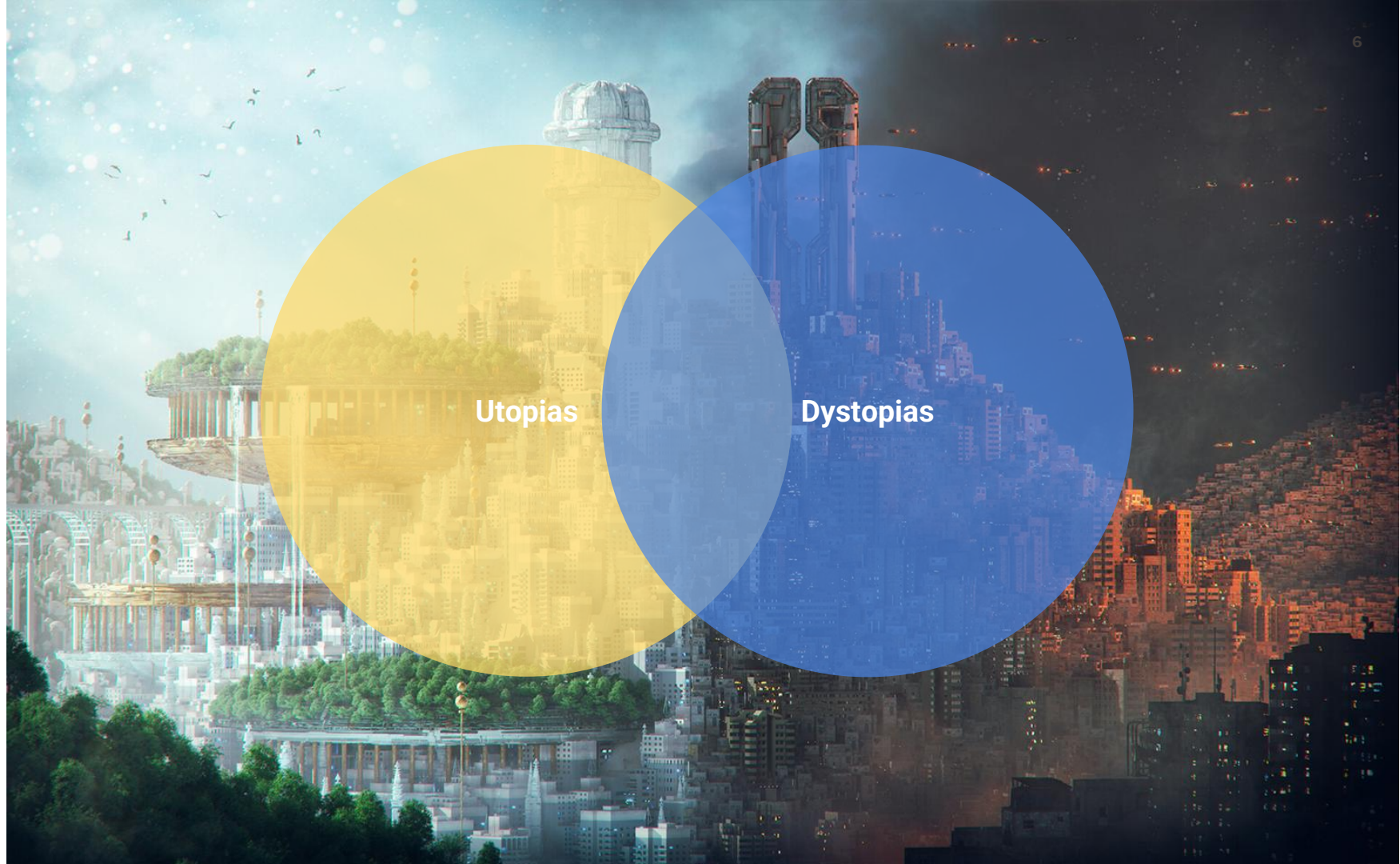
