“Protocol” for the exams

- 1) “Entrance time”: The student enters in the room. An A4 exam sheet with written questions is given to the student.
- 2) “Entrance time” to “Start time”: The student answers in written form to the questions directly on the given A4 exam sheet. No material is allowed (course notes, other notes, books, internet connection, ...are not allowed).
- 3) “Start time” to “End time”: The student discusses with the examiners and complement in oral and written form the written answers. Additional questions might be asked to the student by the examiners.
- 4) “End time”: The student leaves the room.
