

## **Practical Information for the Exam:**

The final exam will be based on the topics covered during the semester

The exam is graded on a scale from 1 to 6, with 1 being the lowest grade and 6 the highest.

- **General Physics III Exam:**

The exam is an individual written test lasting three hours. It consists of several problems, and the points allocated to each problem are indicated in the exam sheet.

- **Identification:**

Each student must bring their Camipro card or, alternatively, a photo ID. Students will write their solutions on the provided sheets. Both the exam sheets and scratch paper will be made available in the exam room.

- **Allowed Materials:**

The only allowed material is:

- writing material such as pens
- food and something to drink
- one calculator (more details below)
- one handwritten A4 sheet (double-sided) with formulas. You can use the tablet to produce this document, but it should be handwritten. More details about the permitted content in the sheet is provided below. Assistants may check the contents of the sheet. If deemed non-compliant, it will be confiscated. It is recommended to have your sheet checked beforehand by the instructor or the head assistant.

Any other item (backpack, bags, etc) must be placed near the blackboard.

- **Content Permitted on the Formula Sheet:**

- Formulas (e.g.,  $Q=C \cdot V$ )
- Titles for formulas or groups of formulas (e.g., "Maxwell's Equations")
- Units of measurement (e.g.,  $E[V/m]$ )
- Explanatory diagrams (e.g., coordinates, electrical circuits, etc.)

- Definitions of variables involved:  $\mathbf{E}$  is the electric field,  $V$  is the voltage, etc.
  - Explanatory text
- **Content Not Permitted on the Formula Sheet:**
  - Screenshots of the slides or of the problem sets
- **Calculator and Electronic Device Rules:**

It's allowed to bring a calculator without equation solver. Assistants may check the calculators and that they do not contain notes, etc. The use of mobile phones, computers, or tablets is strictly prohibited and will result in the exam being invalidated.
- **Exam Protocol:**

Assistants will not answer questions from students. Students may only leave the room after submitting their solutions to the assistants. Students wishing to use the restroom will be accompanied by an assistant. Solutions written in pencil or on scratch paper will not be accepted.
